Clubs/associations outside NNSWF must obtain an interstate sanction from their own state body to participate. Coonabarabran Soccer Club reserves the right to check player identification and club/association registrations as necessary.

Coonabarabran Soccer Club Junior Soccer Gala
Sunday 17th June 2018
Rules

1. No glass containers allowed on the grounds.
2. No alcohol or animals allowed on the grounds. No smoking within the fencelines of the fields.
3. All players must be registered players of a soccer association or club. Clubs/associations outside of NNSWF must obtain an interstate travel sanction from their state body.
4. All players must be named prior to the start of the carnival and team sheets must be completed prior to the first game. Players may only play in one team during the day.
5. Player ages are as at 31/12/2018. If a player is currently 9 years old and turns 10 on or before 31/12/2018, they will be considered to be 10 years old for the purposes of the carnival and must play in the 10 years age group or above. Females are encouraged to play in their age group but may elect to play down one year. Proof of age must be produced on request.
6. Any protest must be lodged by the coach or team manager in writing to the nominated representative within 15 minutes of the completion of said match and must be accompanied by a fee of \$50, which will be forfeited if the protest is dismissed. There shall be no protests regarding refereeing decisions - the referee's decision is final.
7. Teams are required to supply a referee for other games within their age group according to the fixtures supplied. Coaches may jointly referee with the opposition coach if they choose to do so. All referees must supply their own whistle.
8. All matches are 17 minutes long with 3 minutes between matches.
9. Playing divisions and team numbers:

5/6 & 7 years division (4 on the field + 2 reserves)

Teams will consist of 4 players on the field (no goalkeeper) and up to 2 substitutes. Substitutions may be made as often as desired but must be made at the halfway line. All free kicks and penalty kicks are indirect. The offside rule does not apply. All other small sided rules of soccer apply.

8 - 15/16 years (6 on the field + 2 reserves)

Teams will consist of 6 players on the field (5 players and 1 goalkeeper) and up to 2 substitutes. Substitutions may be made as often as desired but must be made at the halfway line. Direct free kicks, indirect free kicks and penalty kicks can be awarded. The offside rule does not apply. All other rules of soccer apply.

10. Points will be awarded as follows:
 - a. 4 points for a win where the score difference is greater than three
 - b. 3 points for a win where the score difference is three or less
 - c. 2 points for a scored draw
 - d. 1 point for a scoreless draw
 - e. 0 points for a loss

If teams are tied on the same points - the team with the highest goal difference will be the winner

If teams are still tied - the team with the most wins is the winner

If teams are still tied - the team with the most goals is the winner

If teams are still tied - a playoff will occur
