## ARMIDALE COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS

---

These Rules & Regulations are specific to the Armidale competition and are in addition to the Northern Inland Football Competition Rules & Regulations.

### Venues

Games may be played at the following venues:

- Rologas Complex – Armidale
- Phil Wheaton Oval – Erskine St Armidale
- Harris Park – Kirkwood St Armidale
- Jack Vallance Oval – Dumaresq St Armidale
- Doody Park – Canambe St Armidale
- TAS Adamsfield – Douglas St Armidale
- Wilson Park – Glen Innes
- Inverell Sporting Complex – Inverell
- Sporting Complex – Walcha
- Sporting Complex – Uralla
- Sporting Complex & Guyra Central School – Guyra
- Newling Oval – Kentucky St Armidale
- Consett Davis fields UNE – Armidale

### Competition

The competition will be played on a “Home & Away” basis where possible.

All Mini Roo games will be played at Rologas with the exception of home games for Uralla, Guyra Walcha or other clubs where a suitable field is available.

Every attempt will be made to ensure that all age groups/divisions have their “home games” on the same day.

When no referee has been available to officiate at a game the coach of each team is to email the results of the game to the Competition Administrator by 9am on the Monday following the game.



### Junior Players

Junior players if they are turning 15 in the year of the competition may play in their club's senior team provided that they are appropriately registered and that a "Parental Consent Form" has been submitted to the Competition Administrator. Exemptions may be applied for and will be assessed on an individual basis.

Where a club has insufficient players to field a complete team in a specific age group but has enough players of varying age to form a team, they may apply to the Competition Administrator to form a composite team. If approval is given the Competition Administrator will advise the club of which age group/division the composite team is to be placed. All applications will be considered on an individual basis.

All games in the final series for juniors will be played at Rologas unless insufficient fields are available.

### 19's Competition

A team may have a maximum of 3 overage players – Over age players MUST have a good playing record as their purpose is to mentor the younger players who play in this competition. The Competition Administrator MUST be given the names of the overaged players in the team prior to the first game. Overage players may also play in the New England League Competition for their Club.

### New England League (Seniors)

To nominate in Div 1 & 2 a club must have sufficient players to field teams in both divisions otherwise they are to nominate their team/teams in Div 3.

If 2 teams for the same club are in Div 3 then a player MUST play exclusively for the one team. The venue for Senior Grand Finals will be decided by NIF but a club may apply to The Competition Administrator to host.
